Due to COVID-19, the start of school will be delayed until September 8, 2020 to prepare our facilities for reopening.

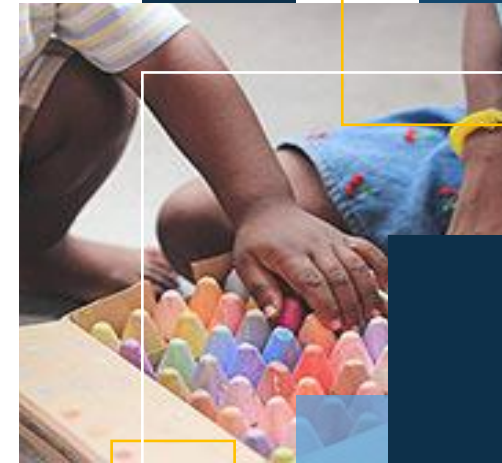

LEARNING MODEL OPTIONS FOR PARENTS

“Blended”/In-Person Model

Students who participate in the blended/in-person learning model will attend school two days per week, and will be instructed virtually three days per week, using an AA (Monday-Tuesday)/BB (Thursday-Friday) schedule. Students will be provided access to direct instruction on the days they are participating in online learning. Parents will be notified of the days their child(ren) are to attend in person.

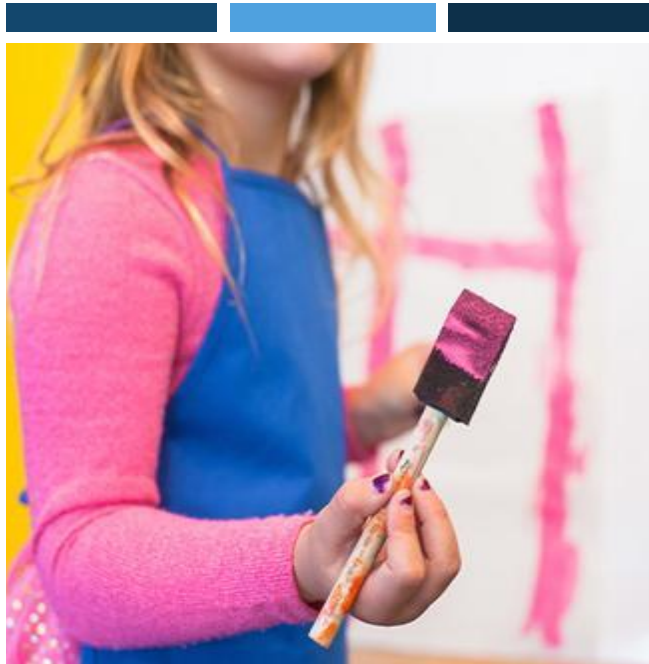
ColletonED Virtual Program

Learning is delivered entirely online to students with Colleton County classroom teachers assigned to support students through 100 percent virtual lessons, 5 days per week. Virtual learning will be a combination of live instruction delivered by teachers through live streamed videos and computer-based programming.

What to expect while in the building?

- Students will be **REQUIRED** to wear face masks unless a student’s medically documented disability prevents him/her from doing so.
- School employees will wear face masks.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in each classroom.
- Class size will be aligned with CDC social distancing guidelines.

BLENDED/IN-PERSON MODEL

- This model will phase into a five-day week when conditions allow for safe transition.

- Your child could receive instruction from teachers across various district schools.
- A device will be provided for students who may need one.
