South Carolina High School Diploma

This pathway offers the only option that is accepted by ALL public and private college institutions, perspective employers and the military. Students working toward a state high school diploma need to obtain the required 24 credits, pass all sections of the EOC tests, and take all parts of the ACT/SAT and WIN tests to receive an endorsed diploma.

South Carolina High School Credential

The South Carolina High School Credential offers applicable students with disabilities the opportunity to work towards a uniform, state-recognized credential. This rigorous, modified, program offers opportunities for hands-on, interactive vocational experiences geared towards post-school success in the competitive job market.



- Requires an IEP
- SC-Alt qualified
- Not = to a diploma
- Referral to SCDDSN

CCSD District Attendance Certificate

For students who complete an educational, occupational, or employment training program without receiving all of the required credits for a South Carolina High School Diploma or South Carolina High School Credential. Students qualify for SC-Alt testing in lieu of general state and district assessments.
