



Adult Students with Disabilities Educational Rights Consent Act

I have been given the Adult Students with Disabilities Educational Rights Consent Act Frequently Asked Questions guidance sheet. I understand that I have to make a choice regarding my educational participation from one of the options below. I also understand that three (3) of the options require further consideration and specific documentation from outside medical and/or legal professionals.

- Student makes educational decisions (automatically occurs at the age of majority–eighteen years old)
- Student makes educational decisions with support and assistance of an adult of his/her choice (informal arrangement)
- Student delegates educational rights to an agent (Requires Delegation Form or Power of Attorney)
- A representative is appointed to represent the educational interests of an adult student while he or she is in school (Requires certification process that involves a medical professional); and
- Educational rights, along with other rights, are assigned to a court-appointed guardian (Requires using Probate Court process)
